

GENERAL HINTS

Never wash embroidery together with starched or stiffened fabrics. If the embroidered articles are starched or stiffened, soak them first in water at about 175° F. (80° C.) to remove the starch or stiffening, then rinse several times.

NORMAL WASHING

- 1 Wash in luke warm soap or detergent suds. Use detergent recommended for colours, but in very small quantity, according to the instructions. Avoid chemicals recommended for pure white. Do not worry if the water becomes coloured. Keep on washing and rinsing in plenty of water.
- 2 Rinse several times in luke warm water, then in cold water. When washing with soap in hard water, revive the colours in water containing 6 or 7 teaspoons of white vinegar per quart of water, then rinse in plain cold water.
- 3 Never leave damp embroidery folded or in a heap.
- 4 Roll the embroidery in a towel and squeeze without wringing, then spread out to air.
- 5 Iron the embroidery on the wrong side between two clean towels with a warm, not hot, iron.

SPECIAL CASES

The high quality of D·M·C fast colours also makes it possible to:

- a Boil embroidery in soap or detergent suds. However, it is essential not to pack the embroidery tightly in the boiler, not to mix it with starched linen and not to squeeze or press it out through a wringer before a thorough rinsing.
- b Dry clean embroidery (benzine, trichlorethylene, etc.). Grease or mineral oil stains may be dry cleaned. Wash and rinse well immediately.
